Geography, DT & PSHE - Textile Recycling for Sustainability



This week, Year 6 has started an exciting project: **You and your T-shirt can make a difference.** Children are asked to bring at least one old t-shirt or another piece of fabric each from home and then work on making it into a new and more useful item. In this project, girls will learn that clothing can be used again in one form or another and discarding would be a waste, not just of the material itself, but of the water and energy that went into the manufacturing. Less energy used means less needs to be generated, resulting in smaller carbon footprints and less greenhouse gases and emissions.

Please take some time to look through your wardrobe and send some old but suitable clothing items (fully washed) to the school so the girls have enough material to work on.
