Next week, we are going to focus our learning on the following:

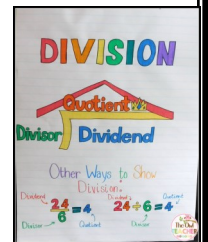
Writing: We have started reading the book *Kensuke's Kingdom* and will be writing a balanced argument.
