Upcoming events:

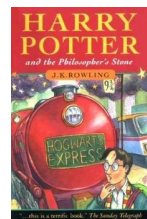
Saturday Tuition resumes this Saturday 27th April – please arrive in good time.

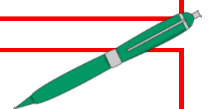
