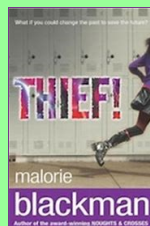

Writing

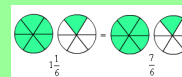

- Memorising science 'Killer Facts'

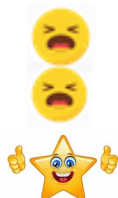
