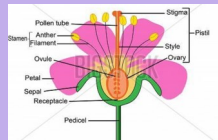


Our topic based Science is :

- Parts of a plant and functions



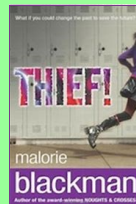

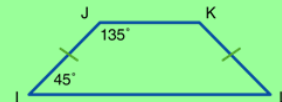
