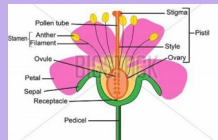


Our topic based Science is :

Do we make the most of what's right on our doorstep?

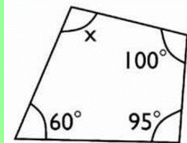
Our study will entail the following:

- Parts of a plant and functions



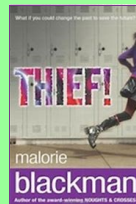
Maths
