Encourage your daughter to find the meaning and use it in a sentence.

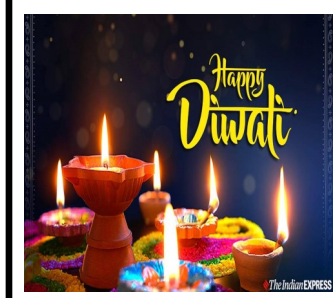
Topic: Due to our harvest rehearsal, some lessons were affected and will be revisited next week.
