We set an activity for the girls in 3.1 to complete this week so we could identify which girls can and can't log into Google Classroom at home.

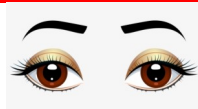
However, only half the girls have responded by completing this task. Please could you assist your daughter with logging into Google Classroom so she can complete the activity.

We have now started column multiplication of 3 digit numbers by single digits.

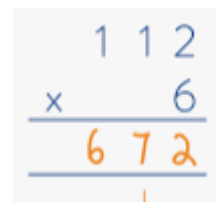
In the middle of next week, we are going to be moving onto division of 2 digit numbers by single digits.
