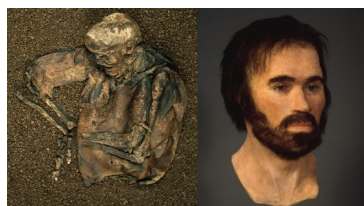

This Week ...

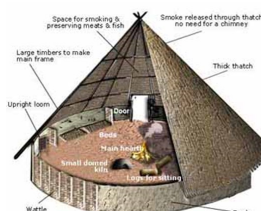


Our starting point this week examines the *Mystery of the Body in the Bog* — the Lindolow Man.

English

Once, they have finished reading their book they can take the RL Book Quiz which normally involves 10 questions.

Next Week ...

Maths

Next week we start a new topic of maths: Multiplication.

At the end of Year 2, the girls should have developed the ability to instantly recall multiplication facts for the:

- 2 times table
- 5 times table
- 10 times table.

This year, they need to be able instantly recall multiplication facts for the:

- 3 times table
- 4 times table
- 8 times table.

How to help them at home ...

Please ensure that your daughter can instantly recall the tables that she learnt in Year 2.

You can also start practising the 3 times table with your daughter until she can instantly recall each one.

$$\begin{array}{l} 1 \times 3 = 3 \\ 2 \times 3 = 6 \\ 3 \times 3 = 9 \\ 4 \times 3 = 12 \\ 5 \times 3 = 15 \\ 6 \times 3 = 18 \\ 7 \times 3 = 21 \\ 8 \times 3 = 24 \\ 9 \times 3 = 27 \\ 10 \times 3 = 30 \\ 11 \times 3 = 33 \\ 12 \times 3 = 36 \end{array}$$
