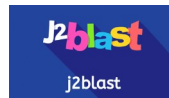
Maths

Next week, we will be writing from a very different viewpoint: Stella the dog. We will analyse Stella's personality and priorities in detail before writing about events on the island from her perspective.



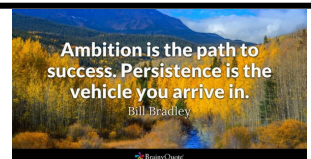
Please continue to encourage your daughter to keep reading for at least 15 minutes every day and to keep taking AR quizzes.

Ambition



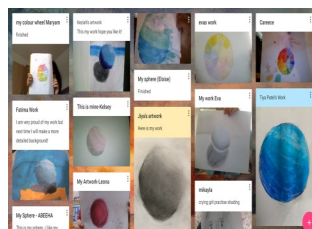
Topic: Who are we and why do we live here? UK and Duluth, Minnesota USA
