Maths

Their knowledge will be tested on how well they understand how to add, subtract, multiply and divide fractions and how to apply this knowledge when calculating word problems.

Topic: Who are we and why do we live here?

Geography: This week the girls were able to identify what makes them unique. Next week we will learn more about our local community Thornton Heath; the girls will describe the human, landscape features and the community. They will write letters explaining how where they live affects who they are.
