Topic: Fairgrounds

Science: This week the girls learned about electricity and electrical circuits. They learnt how to identify different electrical symbols and how to use them to create circuits. For our next lesson, the girls will learn about forces.

Geography: Next week the focus will be on locations of the British isles. We will be identifying physical features of the UK countries on a map and locating areas that have popular fairgrounds.


