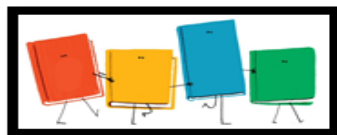


Week ending Friday 5th March 2021

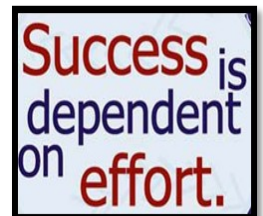
