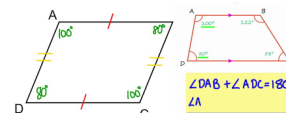
We will have our Virtual Parents' Evening on Tuesday 18th and Thursday 20th of May (4.00—6.30 pm).

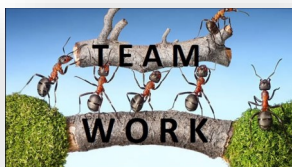
