Year 3 are currently celebrating **Black History Month** a wide variety of interesting and captivating activities, including an upcoming Enrichment Day.

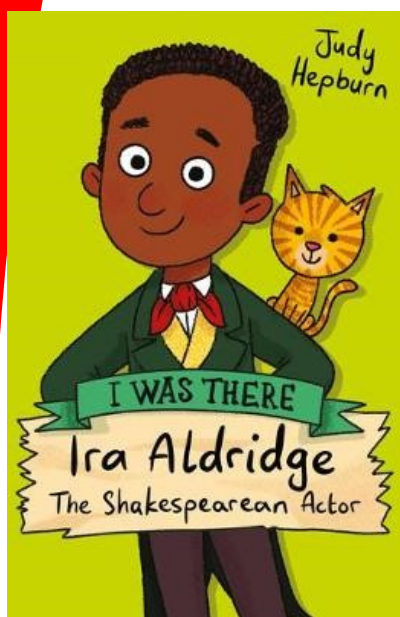
