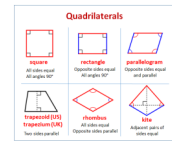

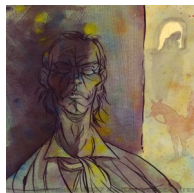
Maths:
