This week, pupils completed their discussion text where they presented the advantages and disadvantages of an issue.

In Maths, they calculated perimeter and area of rectangles and squares.

In Science they looked at the stages of the human life cycle, identifying and discussing the characteristics associated with each stage of human development. They also participated in our **Farm in a Box Project**—investigating wheat: what's inside a seed and its journey from grain to food. They also mixed a simple dough.

On Wednesday, pupils visited St Andrews R C Church where they were introduced to the internal features of the church such as the Sanctuary, font, stations of the cross etc. The significance of each feature was explained by Father Anthony. On their return to school, pupils drew the features and wrote a diary entry.

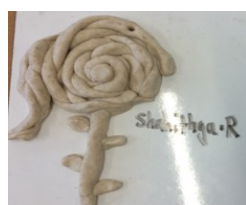
