This week, pupils have written Monologues as a character from the class text: *Lion, The Witch and The Wardrobe*. They have also performed their Monologues.

In Maths, they used the place value chart (when necessary) to multiply whole numbers by 10, 100 and 1000.

In History, they discussed the question "Why do people like us want to remember wars and castles?" Emphasis was placed on the fact that the poppy and the castle are different ways of remembering the past. Pupils then wrote a letter addressed to the RBL Croydon Branch, thanking them for their service to army personnel and explaining how our school participates in this charitable event.

Pupils also discussed the use of Catapults as defence mechanisms during medieval times and how they are used today. This was linked to our **Science** lesson where pupils labelled the parts of the catapult.

On Monday, pupils enjoyed an Enrichment Day where they explored the lives and work of Black British modern and historical people.
