### Christmas Card/Poster Competition:

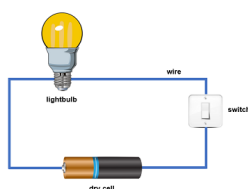
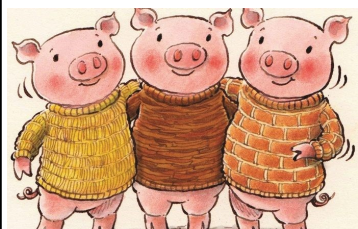
