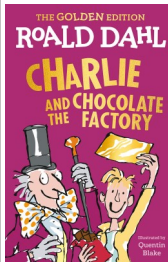

### This Week...

#### English



**Charlie and the Chocolate Factory.**  
We planned and wrote the third and forth part of the monologue from Charlie's point of view. The girls then acted out their monologues

with expression and gestures for emphasis.

#### Mathematics

We examined techniques for multiplying and dividing by 7, 9, 11

and 12. We also looked at dividing with a remainder. On Friday, the girls worked on word problems involving multiplication and division.

#### History and Geography

We discussed the history of chocolate and located chocolate producing countries on a map. We learnt how chocolate was introduced to Europe.

#### Science

The girls learnt about the food value in a bar of chocolate and why eating chocolate must be balanced with physical activities as chocolate also provides fuel/energy for our bodies.

They then inspected chocolate wrapping paper to find out how many calories there are in every 100 grams of each product and compiled a chart from the information.
