This week, Pupils have used experiences from our class novel to write poems about fireworks. They have included features such as rhyme, repetition, onomatopoeia, simile, metaphor and personification, resulting in poems which are enjoyable to read.

In **Maths**, they applied their division skills to fractions, where they converted fractions and mixed numbers to decimals using long division. They also added mixed numbers without regrouping.

Pupils completed an investigation involving the evaporation process—evaporating sugar. They also discussed how surface area affects the evaporation process.

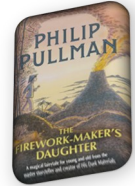
In **RE**, they discussed what Christians learn from the Christmas stories.
