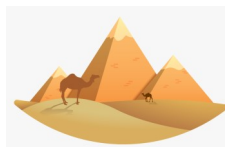

It's been a lovely first week back at WJGS and the girls have dived right into hard work!

Our new topic for this half term is: Who were the greatest builders in the world? The girls will be looking at different builders from different civilisations. They will explore the earliest civilisations and locate where the first towns and cities were in the world. This will then lead the girls to learn about the achievements of the Ancient Egyptians – the period of building the great pyramids!



English: The girls created a fact file for Egypt to gain more of an insight into the area they are writing about for the next few weeks. They have also started writing a set of instructions on how to make mud bricks using imperative verbs!

Maths: The girls are consolidating their understanding of column addition and subtraction of three digit numbers with regrouping, through word problems. They have been learning how to represent the key information in word problems as bar models.
