#### **English:**

Year 3 used their research about key words from the mummification process to write up their mummification report. We are very proud of how much the girls wrote and their focus to detail by adding a range of Alan Peat sentences, time connectives and ambitious adjectives. They are also getting better at reading over their work, reflecting on their sentences and fixing small errors to ensure a flow in their writing.
