Maths:

We have started the new unit called length. The girls have been becoming familiar with the terms centimetres, metres and millimetres, as well as their abbreviations as units. They have also been practicing how to measure using a ruler and a tape measure. They have been able to identify examples of different lengths around the classroom.



Next week, we will be focusing on word problems involving length and the four operations: addition, subtraction, multiplication and division.

The model car is 7 cm 3 mm long.

$$\begin{array}{r} 7 \text{ cm } 3 \text{ mm} \\ \swarrow \quad \searrow \\ 7 \text{ cm} = 70 \text{ mm} \quad 3 \text{ mm} \\ 7 \text{ cm } 3 \text{ mm} = 70 \text{ mm} + 3 \text{ mm} \\ = 73 \text{ mm} \end{array}$$

The model car is 73 mm long.

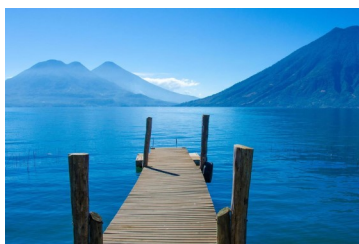
