Lion King Workshop:

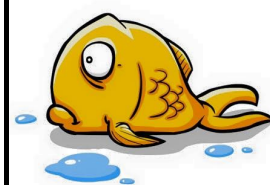
The girls enjoyed taking part in an exciting dance and drama workshop based on 'The Lion King'.
