Topic Day

We had a topic day this Thursday! The girls were able to make connections across the subjects RE, Geography and DT. They learnt about the Mayan creation story and how Mayans believe how the world came about and how the first beings were created to eventually rule the Ancient Mayan civilisation.

The girls then explored in more detail about whether they would like to go to Tikal National Park or Guatemala city in Guatemala. They located the places on a map and learnt about the main things they could do in both areas. They thought about human and physical features of both places and eventually decided where they would want to go and why. Some girls preferred the rural Tikal National Park, whilst other girls preferred the urban Guatemala City.

In DT, the girls created a tube puppet with a sliding, moving mechanism. The tube puppets were based on the characters in the Mayan creation story. They used colourful, vibrant features and explored expressions on their puppets.
