Week ending Friday 17th March, 2023

This week, pupils completed writing speeches based on an event in the class' text. They have incorporated the use of AFOREST and have written examples of effective speeches. In Grammar, they revised adverbs using adverbs of place, time, frequency and manner in sentences.

In Maths they have continued converting between the units of measures for length, mass and capacity, converting metres to kilometres, grams to kilograms and millilitres to litres respectively writing their decimal equivalents.

This week was Science Week and pupils displayed their investigation at our Science Fair. They also participated in a Live Lesson: *How are sheep connected to seaweed?* This lesson reinforced their understanding of the properties of materials, since, they looked at the properties of wool and discussed its connection to astronauts and marine life.

Pupils also participated in an online Sign Language lesson offered by of the British Sign Language Association. Pupils learnt to sign greetings, family, colours, animals and letters of the alphabet.

In RE, pupils discussed God's plan for Jesus Christ, sharing their viewpoint using PEE.

Pupils compared the funfair, carnival, amusement park and fairground, sharing their experiences. They also research carousels across the centuries, noting their evolution over time.
