Maths:

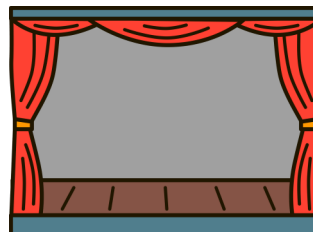
We have been continuing with telling the time. The girls have a better understanding of seconds. They enjoyed trying out different activities and using a stopwatch to time themselves.
