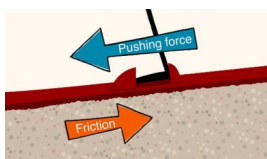

Science:

The girls learned about frictional forces this week. They understood that a frictional force is a force between two surfaces that are sliding. They recognised that a frictional force works in the opposite direction to a push force, to slow an object down or stop it from moving.

We completed a class experiment where the girls explored friction with a toy car as it slid down a ramp of different materials. We used felt, carpet, cotton shirt, corrugated plastic and sandpaper.



Art:

This week, the girls printed with a range of materials. They learnt the printing technique and then thought about how they can print houses, clouds, trees and grass. They decided that they can use different materials for different things.

Next lessons, the girls will create a landscape for their puppet theatre backdrop. They will use the same materials and apply their printing techniques.
