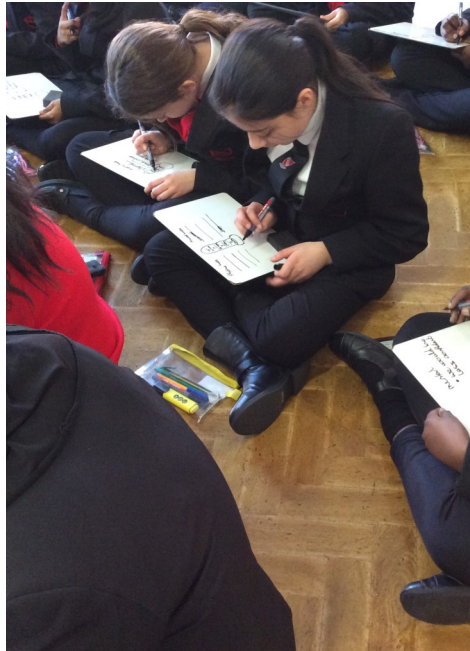
Winterbourne Junior Girls' School Year 6 Newsletter 22
