CATERPILLAR CAM:

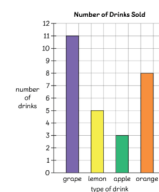
As part of our Science focused topic this half term, Year 3 have a chance to raise caterpillars into butterflies and then release them once they are ready.

The caterpillars arrived this week. They have been placed into their individual pots with their food. They will remain in their pots until they grow and become chrysalis, before they move into their butterfly enclosure.
