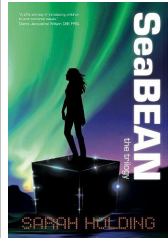

#### English - SeaBEAN



The girls examined the cover and read the blurb of the book to base their predictions of what was going to happen in the story. They then read the prologue and explored the meaning of unfamiliar words in context.

#### Mathematics - Geometry

The girls learnt how to calculate the area of rectangles using multiplication, identify right, acute

and obtuse angles, compare and order angles by size, and how to classify triangles.

#### Science

The girls investigated shadows and what materials provided the best method for blocking light. They grouped materials into transparent, translucent, opaque.
