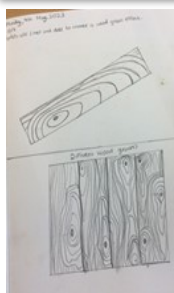


Pupils personalised their carousel toy in **DT**, Adding elements so that it is unique to them.
