This week, pupils expressed their opinion about whether the Highwayman is a hero or villain, using appropriate persuasive language to convince their readers. They also explored the use of present and past tense of the verb "to be" and used these correctly, changing from present to past and vice versa.

In **Maths**, pupils completed the concept of measuring and calculating angles on a straight line and around a point. They were introduced to measuring and calculating angles in a triangle.

In **Art**, pupils explored artistic lines and their quality in preparation for completing a final piece of art of the *Highwayman in the trees*, associated with the Highwayman narrative poem. They drew lines and described them. For example: thick lines denote strength while



curved lines convey energy. They then applied their knowledge to a piece of artwork.

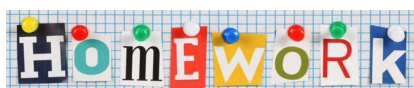
