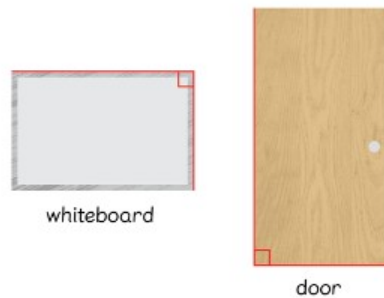
Assessment Week!

Maths:

In Maths, the girls have started a new topic: lines and shapes. They applied their knowledge of right angles to identify and label perpendicular lines, as well as parallel lines. They can recognise that perpendicular lines are two lines that meet to make a right angle and parallel lines are two lines that never meet and never make angles. Ask your daughters to identify parallel and perpendicular lines around the house as they are all around us.

We have started our new topic: How can we make living here better for everyone? We created a topic title page, where we re-capped what we already know and what we will be learning about in the next few weeks.

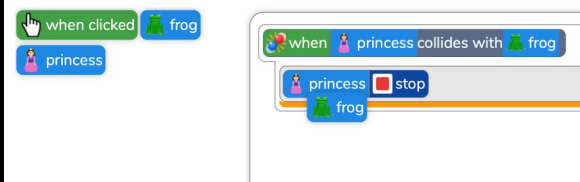
We will be exploring our local area Thornton Heath and we will be thinking about how the change in our local area has been brought about by the humans that live in the area.
