This week pupils completed reading comprehension, revising all the skills learnt in preparation for assessment next week. They were, however, assessed in Grammar. Pupils formed part of the audience for the Winterbourne Debate where they watched a debate competition by members of the school's debate club.

In Maths, pupils were introduced to drawing of the rhombus and parallelogram. They were able to draw a rhombus with one given side and angle and a parallelogram with two given adjacent sides and an angle. Pupils used a ruler, protractor and set square to complete this activity. They also completed Arithmetic assessment.

In Science, they discussed and produced a branching database where they sorted leaves according to various criteria.

Pupils added another page to their comic book (started last week) explaining the information learnt from the SMART crew. They addressed the questions: What should you accept? What is reliable?

On Wednesday, pupils visited the Muththumari Amman Temple in Aurelia Rd, Croydon, as part of their study of Hinduism this term. They were given explanations of why people attend the Temple, listened to some religious music, watched the Abhisheka, which is the ritual bathing of a holy image with sacred water and other substances and enjoyed a guided tour of the Temple.
