This week pupils wrote instructions for making a Necklace based on the story "The giant's Necklace". They wrote the instructions using sophisticated sentence starters and they also discussed and presented a pictorial representation of the instructions.

In Maths, pupils constructed trapeziums using a ruler, protractor and set square. On Tuesday, they built solids using unit cubes in a practical exercise. This was followed by measuring volume.

In Science, pupils began their "Grow your own" project which entails growing an edible salad and which will carry on into the Summer holidays. They explained the parts and functions of the flower in relation to pollination and described the life cycle of the Dandelion flower. Pupils also discussed changes in our body as we enter puberty.

During PSHE, pupils discussed body and self image and the impact of their personal views in relation to how they see themselves. They discussed ways of turning a negative viewpoint into a positive affirmation, to cultivate a healthier self and body image.

During RE, pupils debated the question: *Is it ok to lie?* They discussed the best way for Christians to show commitment to God. They revisited the Ten Commandments and rank ordered them according to which ones they thought showed the most commitment to God.

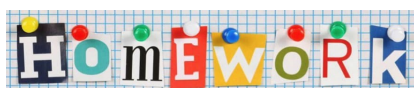
