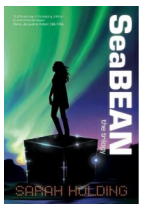

We thought about and discussed our special places and how it makes us feel.

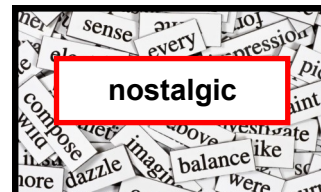
