It was lovely to meet you all at parents evening! We can't believe that there are only two weeks left!

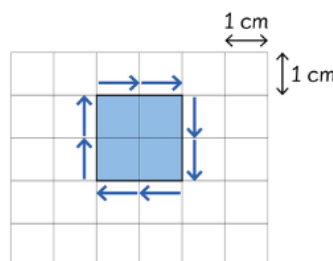
English:

We have finished writing a newspaper report about Naledi and Tiro's journey to Jo'burg. The girls practiced writing adverb from adjective Alan Peat sentences and they learnt the difference between reported speech and direct speech. Particularly as the girls are moving to Year 4 very soon, we learnt about the importance of editing. The girls spent a whole lesson reading over their work, looking for missing words, missing punctuation, incorrect spelling and improving their work further.



Maths:

We have consolidated our topic lines and shapes, focusing on 2D and 3D shapes. This week, we have been learning about perimeter. The girls have understood that finding the perimeter (total length) is finding the total distance around the outside of a shape.
