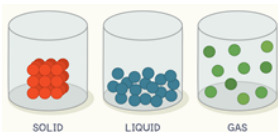
This week, pupils have written poems about fireworks. They have incorporated a range of literary devices such as simile, onomatopoeia, personification and rhyme to create a vivid image for the reader. Pupils also revisited the word meaning and inference skills in Reading Comprehension.

In Maths, pupils rounded numbers to the nearest 10, 100, 1000 10 000 and 100 000.

They applied their knowledge of rounding to find approximate totals for give addition calculations.

Pupils grouped materials into the categories of solids, liquids and Gasses in Science. They are able to describe the movement of particles in each state of matter.

In their RE study of Hinduism, pupils explored the concept of Puja in Hindu Worship. They examined and wrote about the significance of the objects on the Puja tray.

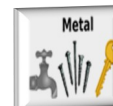
