Winterbourne Junior Girls' School **Year 5 Newsletter**



Week ending Friday 10th November 2023

This week, pupils completed their reading comprehension focussing on word meaning and inference skills. During their writing session, they wrote diary entries as Mr Tumnus, another character in the class novel. They incorporated the features of diaries and included examples of three Alan Peat sentence types. They also explored sentences using the relative pronoun during their Grammar session.

During Maths, pupils were introduced to prime, composite, square and cube numbers. They then multiplied single-digit numbers and 2-digit numbers by 10, 100 and 1000 and 2-digit and 3-digit numbers by a single-digit $3 \times 3 \times 3 = 3^3 = 27$ number using multiple strategies. In History pupils discussed the impact of World War I on people's lives. They recapped knowledge about the Saxons, Normans and castles, after which they decided on what questions they wanted answered.

In ICT, they were introduced to the Game Creator programme where they evaluated 2DIY and 3D Games and chose a theme and setting for their future game.


