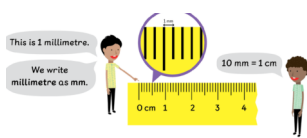

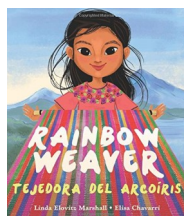
Art:

In Art we are starting the design for the backdrop of our puppet theatre. We have analysed

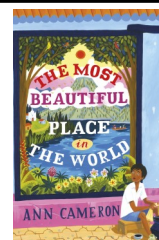
