Science Week 2024:

This week we have explored individuals and teams that challenge long-standing stereotypes, with the aim of encouraging more young people, from all backgrounds, to see themselves as scientists. Focus points were: why they've chosen a career in STEM, how they've followed their passions, and the stereotypes they've 'smashed' along the way.



At WJGS we celebrate the diverse people and careers in science and engineering, we want to encourage pupils to see science in the non traditional way. This will help them to understand and appreciate that the different careers in science are endless.

We have explored those careers they do not readily recognise as or associate with Science. For example, there are video games developers, plant chefs, researchers etc.

Pupils have the opportunity to explore this people: person's name, what they do and also have written a short description of how the person has smashed the stereotypical view of Science.

Next week we will have our Science enrichment day, where they girls can put different scientific skills in to practise, to produce 4 different Science experiment.

Please encourage your girls to tell the time at home using an analogue clock in various ways.

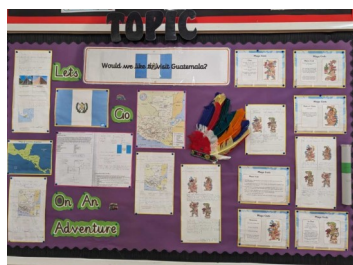


- (a) It is 9:30 in the morning.
