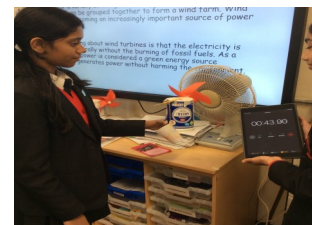
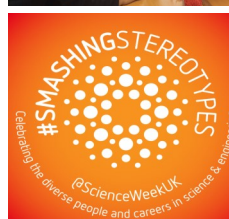
Year 6 SPECIAL EDITION NEWSLETTER
