### Science Week 2024:



We had an amazing Science Enrichment day this week!! We have explored different scientific skills through four different experiments. In the first experiment, we made and tested our pendulum timer. This has helped us to understand the importance of pendulums in clocks. In the second experiment, we have investigated the damage hailstones cause when they are too large to be carried upward any more, and gravity pulls them to Earth. In our third experiment, we have found that moths with certain adaptations are better at camouflaging in the wild. In our last experiment, we were able to explore how acid-base, oxidation-reduction, and heat reaction works together to create invisible ink.

We have had an intense week of learning about time. The girls have recapped their learning from year 2 and have learnt about how to tell the time in different ways.
