English

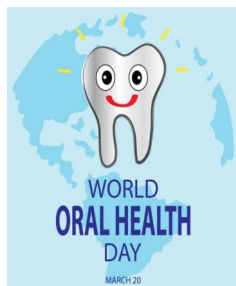
We have continued writing about the storm and started looking at Ariel's part in the storm and the motives behind why she followed Prospero's orders.
