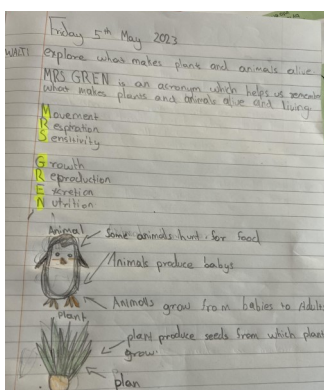
We're working towards Artsmark Awarded by Arts Council England

They learnt about **MRS GREEN** and what the acronym stands for.

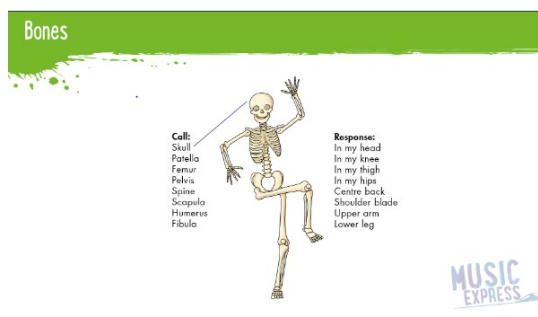
Next week, we will be exploring roots, in more detail and where water goes in a plant.
