
Week ending Friday 10th May, 2024



This week, pupils completed reading comprehension, revisiting all the reading skills explored so far. In Grammar, they discussed how adverbials can be used to show cohesion when writing. During their writing sessions, they wrote newspaper reports based on an incident in the class' novel.

In Maths, pupils calculated angles inside quadrilaterals, solved problems involving parallel lines and diagonals and investigated regular and irregular polygons.

To continue our unit on Hinduism, pupils revisited the concepts of Karma, Samsara, Moksha and Dharma. They compared the Hindu belief of what happens after a person



dies with the Christian belief of this concept.

In PE, pupils developed and applied their seated balance and floor work balance through a focussed skill development session, to modify a non-traditional game and participate in healthy competition.
