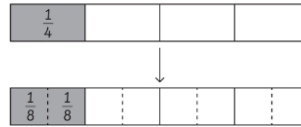
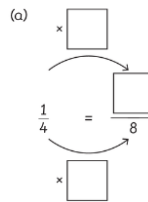
English:

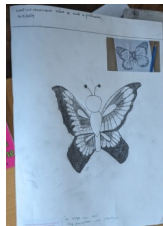
