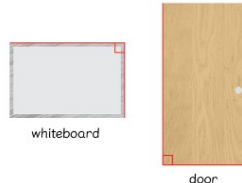

You are always responsible for how you act, no matter how you feel. Remember, that.

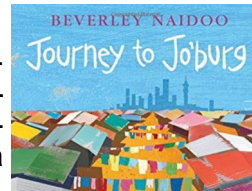
Maths:
